7	Patrol Log Book	The patrol log book is at the meeting and is up-to-date with PLC notes, weekly call log, and patrol meeting notes	10				
8	Patrol Spirit	The whole patrol must say patrol cheer at time of inspection, and full participation in all activities during the inspection	10				
9	Uniforms	% of patrol in attendance that is in complete uniform, % is multiplied by possible points. Patrol should be in full uniform at the begging of meeting, no outerwear, collars in and tucked in	10				
10	Display	Patrol displays patrol name upcoming events and patrol jobs	5
